



Dear Colleagues,

This is a reminder about our hosting the delegation visit of the Edu-Connect Southeast Asia Association, Kaohsiung which will be on 6 February 2020.

Please see attached the itinerary of the delegation including the 6 February visit to Clark and the UPDEPPO.

The team which is a big group of 35 people will include the President of the Philippine Association of State Universities and Colleges (PASUC), and possibly the TECO/MECO representatives.

The delegation will meet up with UPDEPPO on 6 February. They will arrive at the Quest Plus Hotel in Clark around 14:00 for check in. Our meeting with them takes place from 15:30-17:30

at the CDC-OB Montessori Pagsasarili Family Care Center, Clark Polytechnic Compound, Jose Abad Santos Avenue, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga.

If they can check in at the Quest on time or earlier, we may advise them to just go around the UPDEPP campus just to see the site (under construction). No meeting there; just to have a physical sense of the UPDEPP.

They then proceed to the venue of the meeting at the Pagsasarili Family Center. Meeting is for 2 hours. We are arranging the van that will take the faculty from UPDEPP to the meeting place. If you are driving yourself, please try to come and be there on time. The staff will contact you to check whether you are joining the van or going on your own.

The two-hour meeting will involve:

1. Quick Introduction of all people and delegation in the meeting, including TECO/MECO representatives, UP System representatives (EVP, OIL Officials, OVPAO Officials)
2. Video clip of UP Pampanga History (c/o Prof. Ana Marie Alfelor-De Jesus)
3. Discussion on the Proposed Ecozone Management Elective courses under the MM Program of the UPDEPPO. (May I request Prof. Reng Panlilio to please prepare the powerpoint guide showing the MM Program's Tool Courses, Core Courses and the (5) Elective Courses where we will locate the Ecozone Management Courses). We should be able to identify also the possible Elective courses which were discussed in previous preparatory meetings. This flow of the academic program should enable the delegation to appreciate how we envision them to come in and participate. Discussion may ensue from there, considering the Taiwan delegation's proposal.
4. I can give a brief background on the proposed Ecozone Management Elective Course prior to showing the MM Program itself based on #3.
5. We have invited a few Taiwanese locators, courtesy of CDC's Prof. Mariz. It may be good to let them speak a bit on their impressions and plans on collaboration (if any). Those invited to attend can speak English.
6. Summary of Agreed Points and Consensus

The delegation will next head to the Quest Plus Hotel for the 18:30 Dinner Hosted by UPDEPPO/UP System OIL.
